just south of Nakuru town, is surrounded by acacia woodland and rich savannah. Superb example of conservation at work in the wild, it is now, with the assistance of the World Wildlife Foundation, providing sanctuary for Rothschild Giraffe, Black and White Rhino and Leopard who live in perfect harmony in this aquatic landscape. The edge of the lake is frequently a crimson ribbon of Greater and Lesser Flamingos, while pelicans and other water birds swim and fish in majestic flotilla formation. In the early evening, depart for Lake Naivasha. Dinner and overnight at the GREAT RIFT VALLEY LODGE AND GOLF RESORT (F/B)
